The contributors to this one day conference will discuss the extent to which new forms of globalized, financialized, rent-intensive urbanisms revise our understanding of some of the key notions in urban political economy such as urban land rent, growth coalitions, or the urban commons. Speakers involve the members of the URBAN-REV POLITICS research team*, who will share their findings as well as distinguished scholars of urbanism, whose work stretch across real estate studies and critical urban studies. We will examine a broad range of topics including speculative urbanism, financialization and all the frictions thereof including outright contestations.
